Evidence Based Services Committee. (2007, Nov. 27). 2007 Biennial report: Effective psychosocial interventions for youth with behavioral and emotional needs. Hawaii Dept. of Health, Child & Adolescent Mental Health Division.

"This report is an updated review summarizing selected areas of the scientific literature on interventions, services, and medications for youth with significant emotional or behavioral needs. The Child and Adolescent Mental Health Division (CAMHD) of the Hawaii Department of Health Task Force for Empirical Basis to Services issued the original review in August 2000, and its authors disseminated the findings nationally in the journal Clinical Psychology: Science and Practice in spring 2002. Updates have been published in 2002 and 2004." (p. 2).
